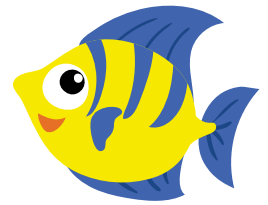
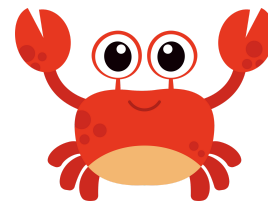


Your essential guide to the Bradninch Town Fair 2025

Saturday 20th September



Bradninch Town Fair dates back to 1208, when the charter of King John granted 'all the burgesses of Bradninch a four-day fair at the Feast of Saint Dionysius'. The Fair was revived as a one-day event in 2021, and has re-established itself as an annual feature in the Bradninch social calendar, now celebrating its 5th 21st century edition!

The Fair is a collaborative community event, loosely coordinated by a volunteer Steering Group. This Fair Day we particularly remember and miss the amazing Jon Williams, who's been at the centre of the event from the beginning. One of many memories is his cheerful dawn transportation of a large pig from its overnight accommodation at the Baptist Church to the Cricket Field on the day of the very first Fair - always going the extra mile to make stuff happen. We hope to make this year's event a cracking one for Jon.

Fair Day is not-for-profit and free to attend, offering a chance for local clubs and groups to promote themselves and raise some cash; for local artisans to sell and show their wares; and for the community to come together for food and drink; performance, play and competition! A huge thank you to everybody who's been involved in pulling this year's Fair together; in particular to the Bradninch and Kentisbeare Cricket Club, the Bradninch Scouts, Bradninch Together and Bradninch Town Council for their support. More volunteers are always welcome!

We hope you have a fabulous Bradninch day! If you enjoy it, please consider dropping some cash in a bucket to help keep the Fair going and free for all! This year's programme and list of contributors can be found overleaf.

Please read the info in this box to help you stay safe and enjoy the Fair

- **The Bradninch Bolt starts in the centre of town at 11 and finishes with a lap of the Cricket Field. Speedy supporters might wish to start in town, then dash down to the field!**
- **Afternoon activity is centred on the Cricket Field.**
- **We encourage folk to sit down and enjoy lunch together at 12ish: grab something from one of the trucks or stalls on site; or bring a picnic (plus a rug or chair!).**
- **Parking on the Cricket Field is restricted to stall holders only. Please walk if you possibly can.**
- **Some stalls and activities will be accepting cash only, so bring some change.**
- **Loos and a First Aid Point are located inside the Kensham Club. The First Aid Point won't be manned constantly but First Aiders' numbers will be located at the bar.**
- **Please keep dogs on leads and pick up poo.**
- **Please ensure that children are supervised. There will be vehicles driving on site at various points during the day.**
- **Please keep off (and keep children and dogs off) the Cricket Square in the centre of the field.**
- **No climbing or playing on the nets at the bottom of the field.**

Details correct at the time of going to press! Anything can happen at the Bradninch Town Fair, especially in the unpredictable autumn - so look and listen out for changes!

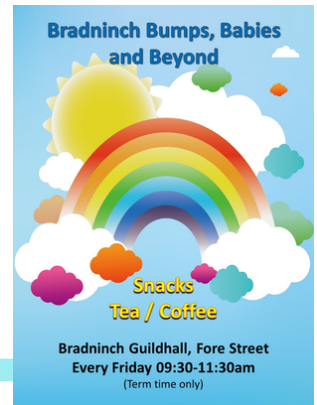
